- Receipts and faxes (thermal paper)
- Rubber
- Textiles
- Toilet paper
- Vacuum cleaner bag
- Video cassettes
- Wallpaper residues
- Wood residues (small parts, dirty, glued)



- Asbestos
- Ash
- Batteries and lithiumion accumulators
- Construction waste
- Drink cartons
- Energy-saving-, LED-, fluorescent- and halogen lamps
- Food waste
- Garden waste (on a larger scale)
- Glass packaging for food such as bottles and jars
- Infectious waste (e.g. medical gloves, medical syringe)
- Insulation material (mineral wool)
- Old electrical equipment (Computer, kettle, keyboard or data carriers)
- Paints, varnishes and oils
- Paper and cardboard (unpolluted)
- Plastic and metal objects (e.g. chairs, car parts)
- Pressure vessels such as gas cylinders, fire extinguisher or aerosol cans (completely emptied)
- Printer cartridges
