includes all organic kitchen waste



- · Fruit and vegetable waste
- Residues of prepared animal products such as meat, sausage, blood, poultry waste, eggs, milk, bacon, fish and bones (smaller than 15cm)
- · Tea and coffee residues and tea bags
- Expired and unpackaged food




- Butcher's shop waste
