| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drink cans (without deposit) • Drink cartons (folded) • Yoghurt pots with separated aluminium lid • Food Tins (empty) • Crown caps • Plastic packaging of food products with separated lid • Meal trays from ready-to-eat meals • Other plastic packaging, bottles, cups, foils, shopping bags, bags • Spray cans (emptied) • Styrofoam packaging • Tubes with separated lid | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Batteries and lithium-ion accumulators • CDs, diskettes, DVDs • Insulation material • Electrical appliances and cables • Rubber waste • Plastic and metal objects (e.g. chairs, car parts) • Dust sheets • Not completely emptied packaging • Foam materials • Video and audio cassettes |

Sorting tips:

Please put only completely emptied packaging in the yellow bin. Please do not rinse or stack one inside the other. Where possible, separate different materials from each other (e.g. aluminium lid from plastic cup).
